

## COVID-19 Guidelines for Wilson County 4-H Meetings

*As of June 2021*

- Based on the latest CDC guidance, fully vaccinated people do not have to wear face masks and social distance.
- We encourage youth under the age of 12 and all participants who are not fully vaccinated to wear a mask.
- Those who feel more comfortable wearing a mask and social distancing can choose to do so.
- Masks will be available for those who need them.
- Sanitation will be readily available
- All surfaces will be sanitized periodically throughout meetings, as well as before and after.
- Any food items served will be prepackaged items from vendors or stores and not touched, cooked or prepared by Extension Agents, volunteers or other 4-H members.

Everybody in attendance **must be able to answer NO** to the following questions before attending. This includes 4-H members, siblings, parents and 4-H Staff that will be in the building.

- Was your temperature 100.4 or above this morning?
- Have you been told to quarantine/isolate by a medical provider or the health department?
- In the last 14 days, have you had face-to-face contact for 10 minutes or more with someone who has or is suspected of having COVID-19?
- Are you experiencing a new cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing?
- In the last 48 hours, have you had at least two of the following new symptoms: Fever, Chills, Repeated shaking chills, Muscle pain, Headache, Sore throat, Vomiting, Diarrhea or Loss of taste or smell?

***If you can answer YES to any of these questions, please stay home.***
