

The 2020-2021 Homeschool Club meeting schedule



COVID-19 Guidelines for Wilson County 4-H Meetings

As of August 2021

- Masks are strongly encouraged for youth events and meetings being held indoors.
- Masks are not required for outdoor meetings.
- We will continue to social distance at meetings when possible and highly encourage youth and families in attendance to social distance as well.
- Masks will be available for those who need them.
- Sanitation will be readily available
- All surfaces will be sanitized periodically throughout meetings, as well as before and after.
- Any food/beverage items served will be prepackaged items.

Everybody in attendance **must be able to answer NO** to the following questions **before attending**. **This includes 4-H members, siblings, parents and 4-H Staff that will be in the building.** Upon sign in for 4-H meetings, you will be asked to sign and date that you have read the below items and can confidently answer no to all of them.

- Was your temperature 100.4 or above this morning?
- Have you been told to quarantine/isolate by a medical provider or the health department?
- In the last 14 days, have you had face-to-face contact for 10 minutes or more with someone who has or is suspected of having COVID-19?
- Are you experiencing a new cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing?
- In the last 48 hours, have you had at least two of the following new symptoms: Fever, Chills, Repeated shaking chills, Muscle pain, Headache, Sore throat, Vomiting, Diarrhea or Loss of taste or smell?

If you can answer YES to any of these questions, please remain home.

All COVID-19 guidelines set in place for Wilson County 4-H are at the recommendation of Regional and State Extension and 4-H leadership through the University of Tennessee. The 4-H Staff continues to monitor the best and current guidelines based on University policy and current guidelines from the county government. As the year progresses, we will keep you up to date on any changes. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us.

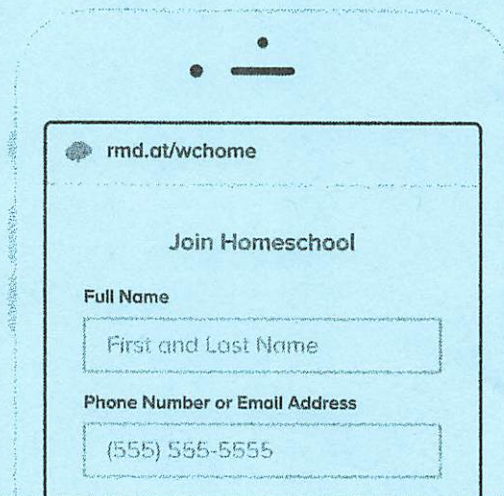

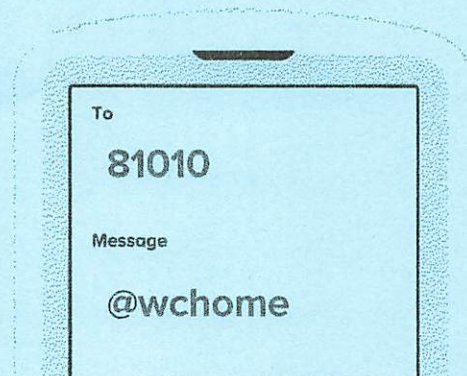
