RULES and Directions:

- 1. Your bank can NOT be bigger than 12 inches by 12 inches! Make sure to measure it!
- 2. It must have an opening to put money in, and a way to take money out without breaking or destroying it.
- 3. Your bank cannot be the same bank as last year!
- 4. You cannot simply buy a bank and decorate it.
- 5. 4-H members must be able to carry their own bank.
- 6. Your bank can be as creative and different as you want it to be! Use any supplies as you want!
- Make sure to label your bank on the bottom or back with your name, grade, school and teacher.

Bring your bank to our next 4-H club meeting! Winning banks in each club will be invited to participate at the county contest this Spring!

This contest relates to 4th grade state standards 4R15.7 and 4.EE.C.9. 5th grade state standards are 5.RI.5.7 and 5.EE.C.9. This contest may be a class requirement. State standards are available on our website.
