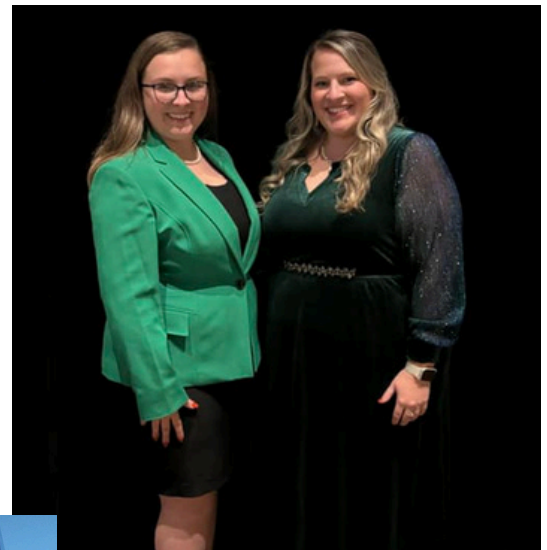

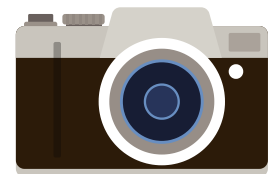
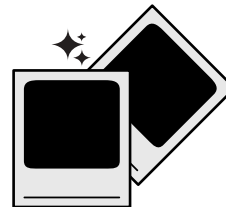
NAE4-HYDP in Boise Idaho
