Positions needed:

Day Camp (June 9-11, 2025)

Adult Leaders: Adult leaders that rotate with and manage groups of campers. May help with set up, take down or other tasks.

Teen Group Leaders: Teen leaders that rotate with and manage groups of campers. May help with set up and take down or other tasks.

Day Camp Leader Training: May 29th, 2025 from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. (UT-TSU Extension Office)

Junior 4-H Camp (June 2-6, 2025): this camp is overnight!

Adult Leaders: Adult chaperones that attend camp all week.

Teen Leaders: Teen leaders that attend camp all week.

Adult and teen leaders attending overnight camp help chaperone and assist with activities throughout the week. Teen leaders will be expected to ride the bus.

Required Camp Leader Meeting: April 24, 2025 from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. (UT–TSU Extension Office)

Camp Launch Party: May 17th, 2025 from 9 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. (James E. Ward Ag Center – East/West Bldg.) –Please plan to attend if at all possible. We will have games and activities to help get campers ready for camp this day. It will benefit you and your campers for them to meet you.
