



So, you want to participate in Fun with Fashion! Here is a step-by-step guide on what you should do and what to expect.

- Mark your calendar. The Fun with Fashion event will take place on August 18 in Wilson County. Registration is at 1:30 p.m. Remember to line up transportation to get you there!
- 2. Read through the scenarios and decide which one or ones you want to participate in. There are three available for each grade level, and you can participate in all three.
- 3. Have someone take you shopping. You want to find and purchase an outfit that fits the scenario. Be sure the outfit fits you nicely and is age-appropriate. Your goal also is to stay within your budget. The scenario will tell you what your budget is. You will use your own money for this (or a parent's). Comparison shopping is advised to help you get the best deal. Always check out the sale racks and watch for good deals! If you want to participate in multiple classes (scenarios), you will purchase multiple outfits.
- 4. Complete your entry form. This will be completed in Microsoft Forms. A link will be available. Ask your 4-H and/or FCS agent about this. He/she can point you in the right direction. You will need to write your own script on your entry form. An emcee will read this aloud as you model your outfit.
- 5. On August 18, be sure to arrive on time. Get checked in at registration. You can arrive wearing your outfit or you can change into it upon arrival. If you are participating in multiple classes (scenarios), you will have clothing changes. Changing rooms will be available.
- 6. We will have a professional on-site to teach you how to model on stage. Don't miss out on this opportunity! This is where you will learn what to expect on stage and how to best showcase yourself and your outfit.





- 7. When it's time for the show, you will line up as directed. You will model your outfit as an emcee reads your script.
- 8. Judges will be watching, and you will get a score.
- 9. After all participants have modeled their outfits, scores will be tabulated, and placings will be announced.
- 10. Tell your friends about this experience, and get them involved next year!
