Dear 4-H Members and Parents:

Thank you for your interest in 4-H Creative Arts (Line & Design). Creative Arts is a group that focuses on arts and crafts, and occasionally fine arts. This year, we will be doing things a little differently to allow for more youth involvement and opportunity. Instead of operating as a monthly club, this year we will be offering three classes in the Fall semester and three classes in the Spring semester, with the opportunity to sign up for individual classes or all of them at the same time. Spring Semester Classes and dates will be announced later this fall.

Fall Classes:

Monday, September 29: Acrylic Paints: Mixing acrylic paints and step by step instructions to paint a canvas pumpkin painting to take home.

Monday, October 13: String Art workshop: Using hammer and nails to create a fun string art board to take home.

Monday, December 8: Wreath Workshop: Make a homemade winter wreath in time for winter and the holidays!

Fees: Each class costs **\$15.00**. OR as a special, you may sign up for ALL THREE classes for **\$35.00** total. Fees can be paid in the office via cash, check (made payable to The University of Tennessee), credit card, or an online payment option is available once all forms have been received.

Location & Times:

All classes will take place at the James E. Ward Ag Center (Wilson County fairgrounds) in the **School Exhibits Bldg. from 5 p.m. - 6:30 p.m.** It is suggested to wear old clothes to ensure your good clothes are not ruined by paint or glue.

Communications:

In the event of inclement weather, we will not have our club meeting if schools are closed, or the Extension Staff feels meeting is unsafe. **Canceled meetings will be made up at another time.** We encourage you to sign up for the free "Band App" service so we

can send you a reminder of the meetings and alert you if there are unexpected changes to the schedule. You will also be able to contact us through the app. A QR code is attached to help you register for this "Band".

Space is limited and will be filled as first come first serve. I have enclosed an enrollment form and photo consent that must be returned to our office along with your class fees in order to reserve a spot for your child.

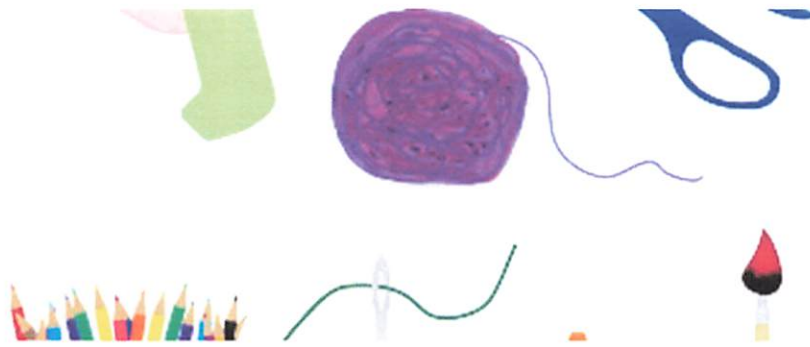
